
ECLIPSES FOR 1891. There will be Four Eclipses this Year, Two of the Sun and Two of the Moon, and a Transit of the Planet Mercury over the Sun's Disk, as follows: I. A Total Eclipse of the Moon. May 23d, invisible in North or South America. I. A Total Eclipse of the Sun, June 6th, visible in North or South America. Toledo, O., to uear St. Louis and El Paso. Invisible in the Wengland, Atlantic, and Gulf States. At Chicago and St. Louis there will be but little more than a mere contact of limbs about 9 o'clock in the morning. At San Francisco the Eclipse begins at 61, 12m. morn., and ends at 7h. 36m. morn. III. An Total Eclipse of the Moon on the evening of November 15th. Visible generally through-out the United States and Europe, Asia, Africa and Sonth America. The size of the Eclipse will be 16.72 digits, the Moon's diameter being 12 digits. The Moon will resto tally Eclipsed on the Pacific Coast, and with the Eclipse upon it partially everywhere west of the Mississippi Valley. Begins, New York City, 5.39. Total begins 6,61; Middle, 7.23. Total ends, 8.05; ends, 9.07 evening. Apply time longitude to these figures for times at other points. IV. A Pertial Eclipse of the Sun December 1st, visible only in southern extremity of South America.

V. A Transit of the Planet Mercury across the extreme sonthern part of the Snn's Disk, May 9th, visible generally west of a line drawn from Charleston to New York City, the Sun setting with the Planet still upon its Disk. The following are the times of beginning of the transit; Washington, 6h. 46m. 66s; San Francisco, 3h. 44m. 1is.; Charleston, 6h. 34m.; Chicago, 6h. 4m.; St. Louis, 5h. 53m.; New Orleans, 5h. 54m.
